To Whom It May Concern,

You will find below the additional information you requested regarding our letter of March 5, 2014.

1. Your request states that effective February 27, 2014, Preston Memorial Hospital became affiliated with Monongalia Health Systems. Please clarify if there has been a change or transfer of control.

With regards to changes of control (transferor and/or transferee, as appropriate):

- a. Provide a complete description of the transaction (transfer of stocks or assets, or merger, is this a direct sale of all assets, equipment, and sealed sources?). Indicate whether the name has changed and include the new name. Include the name and telephone number of a licensee contact who NRC may contact if more information is needed. Preston Memorial Hospital became an affiliate of the Mon Health System. No cash exchanged hands and they will guarantee \$38.5mm in debt for the new PMH hospital being built. All assets and liabilities of PMH became assets and liabilities of Mon Health System effective 2/28/14. PMH retained its name, tax ID number, and Board of Directors with Mon Health System holding certain reserve powers. In essence PMH will continue to operate as it always has prior to the affiliation.
