On October 20, 1966, I transmitted the letter from the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, protesting the issuance of ABC licenses as requested by Carolina Power & Light Company in the captioned proceeding on the basis of an alleged antitrust violation.

By a letter dated December 16, 1966, the Public Works Commission of the City of Fayetteville advised the Commission that it withdraws its request and does not protest the granting of the requested licenses. The letter states that a copy was furnished to you.

In the absence of advice from you to the contrary, we will continue our processing of the application of Carolina Power and Light Company without regard to any antitrust considerations.
