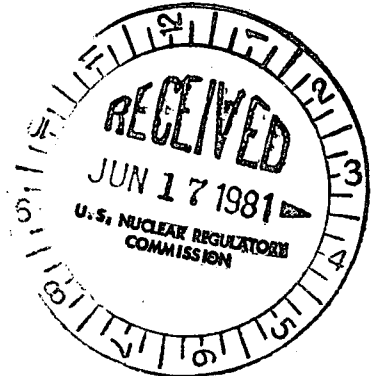

Dear Mr. Stello:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm and document agreements reached between Mr. B. J. Furr, Vice President - Nuclear Operations and Mr. R. C. Lewis of the NRC Region II staff on June 4, 1981, regarding the Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) response to IE Inspection Report 50-261/81-10 and Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalties, dated May 12, 1981.

During the recent steam generator inspections at the H. B. Robinson Plant, an individual was exposed to radiation in excess of the whole body dose limits of 10CFR20.101(b)(1). In order that we may address this event in our response to the subject IE Report, Mr. Lewis has agreed to extend our response time an additional week until June 17, 1981.
