RESCHEDULE OF THE 1996 ANNUAL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EXERCISE**

Gentlemen:

In order to accommodate a number of scheduled activities, one of which is our upcoming refueling outage, the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant (HBRSEP), Unit No. 2 annual Emergency Preparedness (EP) exercise is being rescheduled from July 30, 1996, to November 8, 1996. However, we will continue to conduct EP training exercises as committed to in our Emergency Plan.

This has been discussed and agreed upon with the State of South Carolina Emergency Preparedness Division, State of South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, and the Emergency Preparedness Directors for the risk counties within the ten mile Emergency Planning Zone, (i.e., Darlington County, Chesterfield County and Lee County). The impact on the state and counties, as well as the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is minimal since this is an in-house exercise.
