Gentlemen:

This letter provides the Carolina Power & Light (CP&L) Company revised reply to Violation A identified in NRC Inspection Report 50-261/95-14 dated June 12, 1995, as requested by NRC letter dated September 20, 1995. Specifically, the September 20, 1995 NRC letter requested, in accordance with 10 CFR 2.201(a), a written statement describing steps which have been taken to correct Violation A and the results achieved, corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations, and the date when full compliance will be achieved. The corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved, the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations, and the date when full compliance will be achieved, were provided in our reply to the Notice of Violation for Violation A transmitted by our letter dated July 12, 1995. Specifically, future contractor training programs that will be reviewed by the Plant Training Advisory Board described in our July 12, 1995 letter, will include training on procedural compliance and work supervision.

Additional clarification and correction need to be made with regard to Violation A in our reply letter to the Notice of Violation dated July 12, 1995. We stated that ABB Combustion Engineering Nuclear Power, Inc. was to perform all work in accordance with the CP&L Quality Assurance (QA) program. In fact, the contractor performed work under its own QA program. The incorrect information was the result of a typographical error in the CP&L contract.
