In accordance with my conversation with Mr. G. Requa, the following information is provided concerning the communications with the Company's Emergency Operating Facilities.

The Emergency Operating Facilities (EOF) at the Brunswick Plant and the H. B. Robinson Plant are located on site within the same building as the Technical Support Center (TSC) but outside of the protected area. State and local agencies will not be using the Brunswick EOF for their State Emergency Response Team Headquarters, but have elected to use the N.C. Army National Guard Headquarters in Wilmington, N.C. Adequate telephone lines are available between the N.C. Army National Guard Headquarters and the Brunswick EOF to ensure that Federal, State and local officials can communicate with dose projection and decision making personnel in the Brunswick EOF during an emergency.

Similarly, State and local officials will not be using the Robinson EOF for their Forward Emergency Operations Center, but have elected to use the Darlington National Guard Armory in Darlington, S.C. Adequate telephone lines

are available between the Darlington National Guard Armory and the Robinson EOF to ensure that Federal, State and local officials can communicate with dose projection and decision making personnel in the Robinson EOF during an emergency.
