This letter supersedes my letter on the same subject of April 8, 1983. This is to confirm a commitment made to members of your staff during a telephone call on April 1, 1983, that Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) will modify its Robinson and Brunswick Emergency Plans to designate an alternate location for utility, local State and Federal personnel who would normally proceed to the Emergency Operations Facility (EOF), but for radiological protection reasons could not to travel to our EOF. These alternate locations have been identified to be the Brunswick County Office Complex located in Bolivia, North Carolina for Brunswick (11 miles from the site), and the National Guard Armory located in Darlington, South Carolina for Robinson (18 miles from the site). These facilities presently have direct communication links with their respective Technical Support Center (TSC) and EOF and will thereby allow free interchange of information between off-site officials and those persons located in the TSC and EOF responsible for dose projection and management decision making.

We have contacted appropriate persons within state and county government and they have agreed to provide the above locations for this purpose.

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April 14, 1983

We believe that with this commitment and the information we have previously supplied to you, we have satisfied the need to provide an alternate location at a distance greater than 10 miles from the Robinson and Brunswick sites.
