Gentlemen:

Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) has reviewed, and is pleased to submit, this response to the proposed changes to current regulations on monitoring the effectiveness of maintenance programs at nuclear plants noticed in the Federal Register, page 15303, on March 22, 1993.

Carolina Power & Light Company agrees with the proposed regulations that will change the required frequency of maintenance activity evaluations from annually to at least once every refueling cycle, but not to exceed 24 months. The proposed change in regulations will provide the opportunity to substantially improve the information basis for detecting and correcting potential problems through the maintenance monitoring program. The Nuclear Management and Resources Council (NUMARC) letter to the NRC, dated April 12, 1993, in response to the Federal Register notice was also reviewed; and CP&L agrees with the comments therein.
