EXTENSION REQUEST FOR RESPONDING TO A NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND  
PROPOSED CIVIL PENALTY FOR ENVIRONMENTAL QUALIFICATION DEFICIENCIES

Dear Dr. Grace:

On June 16, 1988, the NRC issued a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty (Notice) for deficiencies relating to environmental qualification (EQ) of electrical equipment at H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant, Unit No. 2 which requested a response within 30 days of the date of the Notice. In response to our July 14, 1988 request for additional time, you granted a 30-day extension. As we indicated in our request, the additional time was necessary in order to have a meaningful opportunity to respond because this enforcement action is based on a new enforcement policy: the "Modified Enforcement Policy Relating to 10CFR 50.49" (Generic Letter 88-07). The absence of enforcement history on this new policy creates a special circumstance not generally found in enforcement cases proposed under the Enforcement Policy of 10CFR 2, Appendix C. Unfortunately, preparation of the response has proven to be more time-consuming than originally anticipated. Therefore, CP&L requests that the response due date be further extended until September 1, 1988.
