Carolina Power & Light Company has received your "Correction to the Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty Dated June 16, 1988" (NOV) dated December 20, 1989. We have reviewed our September 1, 1988, response to the initial NOV against the corrected NOV. In several cases, our initial response argues against enforcement actions for the specific inspection findings. However, the overall response presented remains valid whether the findings are considered as individual violations or aggregated as an EQ Category A problem.

Per discussions on January 3, 1990, with Mr. Hugh Dance, NRC Region II, the reference in the corrected NOV to the mitigating factors specified in 10CFR2, Appendix C, Section V.B, should be to the appropriate mitigating factors contained in Generic Letter 88-07, "Modified Enforcement Policy Relating to 10CFR50.49, Environmental Qualification of Electric Equipment Important to Safety for Nuclear Power Plants", as stated in the June 16, 1988, NOV.

In conclusion, CP&L feels that the September 1988 response to the initial NOV is the appropriate response to the corrected NOV.
