This letter is written to document a discussion of September 12, 1989 between Mr. Robert G. Black, Jr., Manager, Emergency Preparedness, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) and Mr. W. H. Rankin of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Region II.

The purpose of this discussion was to inform the NRC that the 1989 exercise scenario for the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant will be submitted no later than October 13, 1989. Since NRC guidelines require a scenario to be submitted 45 days in advance of an emergency exercise, which in our case is September 29, 1989, CP&L offers the following information as extenuating circumstances for delaying this submittal:

- Key individuals who were assigned to the scenario development team from the plant operations, maintenance, and health physics organizations were diverted to support high priority activities including: a forced outage to review, evaluate, and modify the auxiliary feedwater system; and an NRC evaluation team inspection of the emergency operating procedures, and
- Resolution with South Carolina concerning exercise events, exercise timeline, and level of participation of county and state agencies was only just recently finalized.

CP&L understands and accepts that the NRC review of the scenario will be limited, prior to the exercise, due to the late submittal; however, CP&L is committed to providing a quality exercise scenario which will adequately test the Robinson Emergency Preparedness Program.
