Gentlemen:

Carolina Power and Light Company (CP&L) has received and reviewed the Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance (SALP) transmitted by letter dated March 23, 1990. This report provided results from the evaluation period of November 1, 1988 through December 31, 1989. Also, CP&L had the benefit of comment and discussion during the NRC presentation of the SALP Report at our facility on March 30, 1990.

In general, CP&L is pleased with the quantitative ratings of the SALP Board which reflect good overall performance. It is encouraging that acknowledgment was made of significant improvement in the area of radiological controls, and of continued strength in the area of plant security. Recognition of strong performance in the emergency preparedness response to actual plant events is also gratifying.

However, the staff at H. B. Robinson Unit 2 is keenly aware that a number of functional areas require further focus and attention. We recognize that the SALP ratings received depend to a certain degree on effective and timely implementation of future corrective actions, and we are committed to meeting these obligations. For areas where corrective actions are being developed or issues are being addressed, we are dedicated to completing these activities and providing auditable results.


