





PRIVACY AND PROPRIETARY MATERIAL IN EMERGENCY PLANS

Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

In response to your letter of July 9, 1981, Generic Letter No. 81-27, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) has reviewed the emergency plans and implementing procedures for its Brunswick (BSEP) and H. B. Robinson (HBR) plants with respect to privacy and proprietary material. CP&L concurs that home telephone numbers and home addresses involve personal privacy. Several of these items have been identified in the BSEP and HBR Plant Emergency Procedures which were submitted on March 30, 1981 and February 25, 1981, respectively. Therefore, it is requested that the following information be removed from Appendix A of each plant procedure, as described by your letter, prior to placing the Plant Emergency Procedures in the Public Document Rooms:
