Dear Ms. Diggs:

We have received your July 3, 1979 letter which requested payment of approval fees for Carolina Power & Light Company's (CP&L) Contingency Plans which were transmitted to the Staff by our March 23, 1979 letter.

Your letter stated that the Contingency Plans require Class III fees of \$4000 each for H. B. Robinson and one of the Brunswick units and a duplicate fee of \$400 for the second Brunswick unit. Our check in the amount of \$8400 is enclosed as requested. However, since a contingency plan is a site-specific document which does not require a parallel review for a second duplicate unit at a site, we believe that the \$400 duplicate fee should be refunded to CP&L.
