Dear Mr. Denton:

This letter is to confirm a conversation between Mr. Ed Williams of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Inspection & Enforcement staff in Washington and Mr. R. G. Black of Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) concerning the acceptability of the Emergency Response Facilities at CP&L's Brunswick and Robinson plants. Carolina Power & Light Company has received a letter from Mr. D. B. Vassallo dated May 19, 1982, which approved the present locations of the Technical Support Centers (TSCs) and Emergency Operations Facilities (EOFs) at both plants. Radiation Shielding Analyses were submitted to NRC for Brunswick and Robinson on August 4, 1982 and October 4, 1982, respectively, and have been verbally approved by NRC technical reviewers.

Subsequently, by letter dated April 14, 1983, CP&L committed to establish alternate locations where offsite personnel could assemble to communicate with the EOFs. The locations of these alternate facilities have been found to be acceptable, and Mr. Williams has therefore informed us that our emergency facilities at Brunswick and Robinson meet the Commissioners' requirements and are acceptable. Mr. Williams indicated that formal documentation of this approval would be forthcoming. Carolina Power & Light Company therefore considers this matter resolved.
