SUMMARY

In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, Parts 50.90 and Part 2.101, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) hereby requests revisions to the Technical Specifications (TS) for the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant Unit No. 2 (HBR2). These revisions are administrative in nature.

DETAILS

These requested revisions clarify the qualification requirements for alternate members of the Plant Nuclear Safety Committee (PNSC); make the list of technical disciplines for the Corporate Nuclear Safety Section (CNSS) Independent Review consistent with ANSI N18.7-1976; incorporate mechanical snubbers installed during the last refueling outage; incorporate Standard Technical Specifications (STS) terminology regarding the Administrative Control of High Radiation Areas; revise the Acceptance Criteria for the Integrated Leak Rate Test (ILRT); revise staffing specifications to be in accordance with requirements; and correct typographical errors and inconsistencies.

Attachments 1 through 7 to this letter include the details concerning each requested revision, a summary of the safety analysis and significant hazards determination, and the affected TS pages.

As mentioned above, a safety analysis and significant hazards analysis has been performed on each of the changes requested. As a result, CP&L has concluded that these changes do not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated, or create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident from any accident previously evaluated, or involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety. In addition, according to the staff guidance provided in Generic Letter 83-19, administrative changes to TS are not likely to involve significant hazards considerations.
