SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST FOR LICENSE AMENDMENT
RADIOLOGICAL EFFLUENT TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Dear Mr. Varga:

In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, Parts 50.90 and 2.101, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) hereby requests revisions to the Technical Specifications (TS) for the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant Unit No. 2 (HBR2). These revisions supplement CP&L's October 25, 1983 submittal concerning the Radiological Effluent TS (RETS).

DETAILS

While developing implementation plans for the RETS, CP&L has determined that a change is necessary to Table 3.17-1. There is a large variety of species of fish in Lake Robinson and it is unnecessary and impractical to sample each species as currently required by the proposed table. Therefore, a change has been made to page 3.17-8 to ensure that at least an acceptable minimum of varieties of fish be sampled while not requiring one of each species. Any recreationally important fish in the free swimmer species category represents an adequate monitor of the dominant radionuclides moving through this dose pathway to man; therefore, only a single species is necessary to be sampled. Similarly, a bottom feeder is an adequate representative of its category. In addition, due to an editorial error, Sections 4.18 through 4.20 of our October 25, 1983 submittal have been renumbered to become Sections 4.19 through 4.21. These changes have been discussed with your staff in a telephone conference call on January 30, 1984.

ADMINISTRATIVE

The revised proposed RETS pages are attached. Changes are denoted by vertical bars in the right margin. Please replace the appropriate pages of our October 25, 1983 submittal with those attached. Since this revision is a supplement to our previous submittals, CP&L has determined that no license amendment application fee is required.

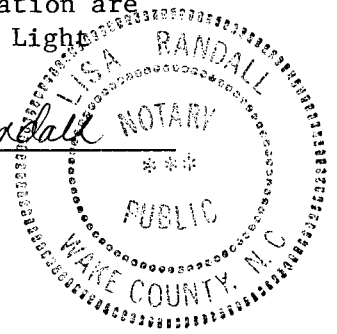
