REQUEST FOR LICENSE AMENDMENT - ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, Parts 50.90 and 2.101, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) hereby requests a revision to the Technical Specifications (TS) for the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant, Unit No. 2.

The proposed change reflects the current organization for support of H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant, Unit No. 2 as well as incorporates the existing requirement in Section 6.17 for Plant Nuclear Safety Committee (PNSC) review of major changes to waste treatment systems into the PNSC activities delineated in Section 6.5.1.6.6.

SIGNIFICANT HAZARDS ANALYSIS

Carolina Power & Light Company has reviewed the subject TS change request in accordance with the standards set forth in 10 CFR 50.92 and determined that this change does not constitute a significant hazard based upon the following considerations:

1. Operation of the facility, in accordance with the proposed amendment, would not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously analyzed because the amendment changes the organizational structure to reflect organizational changes due to promotions and reorganization without any reduction in the level of management oversight of activities affecting plant safety. Further, the redundant addition of a requirement for PNSC review to Section 6.5.1.6.6 provides further assurance that such reviews will be appropriately carried out.
2. Operation of the facility in accordance with the proposed amendment would not create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident from any accident previously evaluated because the amendment changes the organization due to promotions and reorganization without any reduction in the level of management oversight of activities affecting plant safety. Further, the redundant addition of a requirement for PNSC review to Section 6.5.1.6.6 provides further assurance that such reviews will be appropriately carried out.
3. Operation of the facility, in accordance with the proposed amendment, would not involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety because the amendment changes the organization structure to reflect organizational changes due to promotions and reorganization without any reduction in the level of management oversight of activities affecting plant safety. Further, the redundant addition of a requirement for PNSC review to Section 6.5.1.6.6 provides further assurance that such reviews will be appropriately carried out.
