This letter is in response to your letter of June 4, 1980, requesting further information on the subject "Administrative Controls for Fire Protection."

With regard to the NRC position both on fire drills and controls of combustibles, CP&L will develop programs which will adhere to the requirements to be set forth in the final approved version of the proposed Appendix R to 10CFR50.

Carolina Power & Light Company will develop a program which meets the guidelines set forth in Attachment 6 of NRC's letter entitled "Nuclear Plant Fire Protection Functional Responsibilities, Administrative Controls and Quality Assurance." Recent procedural changes have brought us essentially into compliance with these guidelines and any further changes will follow the timetable set forth in the final approved version of the proposed Appendix R to 10CFR50.


