Please find enclosed the revised Training Programs for H. B. Robinson  
Unit No. 2, the Instructor Requalification Program, and the Operator  
Requalification Program.

The Training Programs have been modified as necessary to provide for:

1. Training in heat transfer, fluid flow, and thermodynamics.
2. Training in the use of installed plant systems to control or  
mitigate an accident in which the core is severely damaged.
3. Increased emphasis on reactor and plant transients.

These revised programs are submitted for OLB review in accordance  
with Section A.2.c of the subject letter.

The Instructor Requalification Program was formulated to assure our  
instructors are cognizant of current operating history, problems, and  
changes to procedures and administrative limitations. This program  
is submitted for OLB review in accordance with Section A.2.e of the  
subject letter.

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The Operator Requalification Program has been revised in accordance with Section C of the subject letter to include instruction in heat transfer, fluid flow, and thermodynamics; mitigation of accidents involving a degraded core; the 80/70 grading criteria; and the inclusion of the manipulation requirements. The organizational update at the H. B. Robinson Unit No. 2 has been included. The March 28 letter did not require the submittal of the Requalification Program for OLB review. It is our understanding that changes can be made to Requalification Programs without prior NRC approval so long as the changes do not diminish the scope, time, or frequency of conduct of the various portions of the program. Consequently, we are submitting this updated Operator Requalification Program for your information only.
