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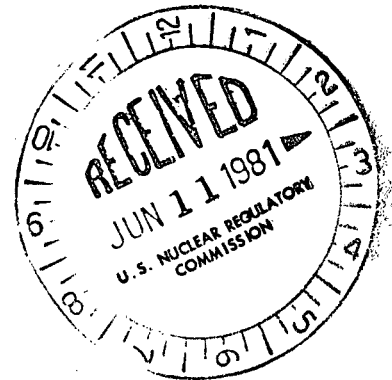

Summary and Background

In a letter dated March 18, 1981, Serial No.: OQA-81-026, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) restated its Operations Quality Assurance Program commitments for the Brunswick and H. B. Robinson nuclear units. This letter stated that implementation of new QA commitments would be completed by April 23, 1981 for Robinson and May 29, 1981 for Brunswick unless otherwise notified. We have completed implementation of the majority of the new QA program described in our March 18, 1981 letter, and in the interim, our current QA commitments have been effective.

During this period, some of the same personnel involved in implementing our new QA program have also been involved in the outage work being performed at Robinson to inspect the steam generators, the present outages on both Brunswick units, the Robinson emergency exercise, and the recent INPO inspection at Robinson. In addition, we have determined during this QA implementation phase, that additional work is needed to maintain consistency between plant QA procedures at Brunswick and Robinson.


Schedule

In light of the above, Carolina Power & Light Company now intends to complete the implementation of our new QA commitments by August 1, 1981 for H. B. Robinson and by September 1, 1981 for Brunswick. In the

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interim, appropriate current QA commitments will remain effective to ensure a completely acceptable QA program.
