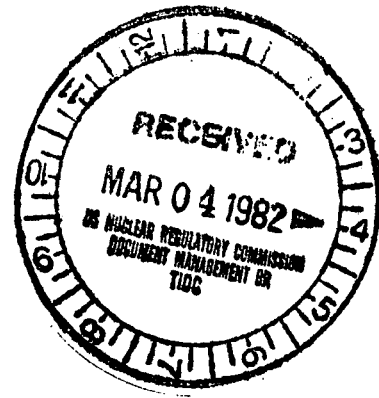

Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

Carolina Power & Light Company's letter of December 23, 1981 reiterated CP&L's previously submitted commitment that NUREG-0737 Item II.B.3 - Post Accident Sampling, would be completed during the next refueling outage. Upon re-examination of the outage workload, and the resources available, CP&L now believes that only the outage related portions of this modification can be accomplished in a reasonable manner during the refueling. The non-outage related work will be completed after the refueling outage. CP&L, therefore, revises its commitment with respect to Item II.B.3 such that the Post Accident Sampling Modification will be completed and the system operational by September 1, 1982. During the brief interim time between the end of the refueling and the completion of the modification, the previously established procedures for obtaining post accident samples will remain in effect.
