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

Based on discussions with Mr. Ed Williams, Mr. Jim VanVliet, and Mr. Dale A. Kers on April 8, 1982 we are providing drawings for your concurrence, showing the location of our proposed emergency response facilities and the security provisions for including the Technical Support Center (TSC) within the Protected Area at the H. B. Robinson and Brunswick Steam Electric Plants. As discussed in our meeting, the proposed facilities will normally be used for training outside the Protected Area, and the TSC will be incorporated within the Protected Area only in the event of an emergency or an emergency exercise. The proposed location and security provisions allow timely access from the TSC to the Control Room with no intervening security barrier.

As discussed, a separate submittal will be filed to demonstrate acceptable radiological and habitability design for the emergency response facilities.

While we do not consider the attached to be Safeguards Information, it is requested that this information be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(d)(1).

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
