CSEN Background

- The NRC published the cyber security event notification (CSEN) requirements as part of the enhanced weapons proposed rule in February, 2011.
- In January, 2014, the Commission bifurcated the CSEN requirements from the enhanced weapons rule to speed up the issuance of the CSEN final rule.
- All documentation related to the CSEN rulemaking can be reviewed on the [regulations.gov](http://www.regulations.gov) website by searching for the NRC Docket ID “**NRC-2014-0036**”.

Next Steps

- The next rulemaking steps will be:
 - The NRC staff will review the feedback from July 31, 2014, CSEN public meeting to determine if changes to the implementation date is needed.
 - Changes made to the proposed implementation date will be documented in the final rule *Federal Register* notice.
 - The NRC staff expects to issue the final CSEN rule in the first quarter of 2015.
- Any new or revised guidance documents will be issued at the same time as the final rule.

Implementation Date

- 180 days to implement CSEN final rule.
 - Consistent with proposed rule implementation date.
- Implementation date considerations:
 - Time to develop and/or revise procedures specific to CSEN requirements.
 - Time to develop and conduct training specific to CSEN procedures/requirements.
- Implementation date factors:
 - CSEN process is consistent with existing notification processes (e.g., 10 CFR 50.72, 73.71).
 - Familiarization with cyber security event notifications (i.e., voluntary initiatives).
