Calculation of GL Storage Terms

- **10 CFR 72.212(a)(3):**

The general license for the storage of spent fuel in each cask fabricated under a Certificate of Compliance shall commence upon the date that the particular cask is first used by the general licensee to store spent fuel, shall continue through any renewals of the Certificate of Compliance, Unless otherwise specified in the Certificate of Compliance, and shall terminate when the cask's Certificate of Compliance expires.

Calculation of GL Storage Terms

- **10 CFR 72.212(a)(3) (Cont' d):**

For any cask placed into service during the final renewal term of a Certificate of Compliance, or during the term of a Certificate of Compliance that was not renewed, the general license for that cask shall terminate after a storage period not to exceed the length of the term certified by the cask's Certificate of Compliance. Upon expiration of the general license, all casks subject to that general license must be removed from service.

General License (GL) Terms

From SOC's response to Comment 5:

- GL term is based on license and the term specified in those license.
- initial + successive renewal terms \neq term of GL
- GL term is determined by the term in the CoC in effect at the time the cask is placed into service.
- GL shall not be longer than the term in effect at the time the cask is placed into service.
- If renewed, GL will terminate at the expiration of the CoC.
