STAFF AND CONTRACTORS CONCERNING CONTENTS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS OF NRC'S TECHNICAL EVALUATION REPORT
REGARDING DOE'S DRAFT BASIS FOR A WASTE DETERMINATION FOR
CLOSURE OF H AREA TANK FARM, SAVANNAH RIVER SITE

On July 21, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff convened a public meeting with U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) technical staff, and contractors. The purpose of the meeting was to allow NRC staff to apprise DOE staff and contractors of the contents and recommendations contained in NRC's recently released Technical Evaluation Report (TER) regarding DOE's draft basis (and related performance assessment) for a waste determination for closure of H Area Tank Farm at the Savannah River Site near Aiken, SC. The TER is part of NRC's consultation responsibility per Section 3116 of the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005. The meeting was held at the Doubletree Hotel in Augusta, GA. Remote access was provided by telephone.
