This RAI addresses Functional Design Qualification and Inservice Testing Programs for Pumps, Valves, and Dynamic Restraints as discussed in Section 3.9 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 9.

UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to RAI 421, Question 03.09.06-10. The response to RAI 421 will be provided by September 12, 2014.

Our response does not include any new regulatory commitments. This letter does not contain any sensitive or proprietary information.


