Regarding the Order issued in the above-referenced matter, I respectfully request an extension of time in which to submit a written answer and to determine whether to request a hearing or to seek to engage in the alternative dispute resolution process (ADR). The reasons for the requested extension are the seriousness of the NRC's findings and the severity of the agency's prohibition against me and the fact that I have just recently retained legal counsel to advise me on my position.
