Dear Sir or Madam:

In letter GNRO-2008/00066, Entergy Operations, Inc. (Entergy) committed to evaluating and providing a submittal, as appropriate, to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), communicating the proposed changes to the plant technical specifications for the adoption of TSTF-523 (Reference 2). Entergy committed to completing the review and submittal actions within 90 days of the issuance of TSTF-523, which was issued in January 2014. The submittal of the proposed changes to the plant technical specifications was not submitted within 90 days of the issuance of TSTF-523.

Entergy has completed its review of TSTF-523 and is developing a submittal to the NRC requesting an amendment to its technical specification to allow the adoption of TSTF-523. This license amendment request should be submitted to the NRC no later than October 31, 2014.
