This letter refers to an investigation conducted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI) to determine if a former warehouse/yard inventory supervisor employed by Chicago Bridge and Iron in Lake Charles, Louisiana (CB&I-LC) was discriminated against for raising nuclear safety concerns.
