Attached is a letter from my management requesting an amendment to our NRC License so we can recycle a neutron source no longer needed by the Bureau of Land Management. I'm also providing the supporting documentation mentioned in the letter. You should receive this in the mail early next week, but I wanted to share this with you now in the hope of getting the amendment approved earlier.

If the amendment process can be completed quickly, we would be looking to make this transfer before July 4 so we can use the source in a field exercise / training event with the 64<sup>th</sup> Civil Support Team in New Mexico during the week of July 7<sup>th</sup>.
