Dear Mr. Lieb:

On August 1, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security inspection at your Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station. On August 7, 2014, the NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with Mr. Gregory Cramer and other members of your staff. Inspectors documented the results of this inspection in the enclosed inspection report.

NRC inspectors documented one finding of very low security significance (Green) in this report. This finding involved a violation of NRC requirements. A cross-cutting aspect was assigned to this finding in the area of Human Performance – Training [H.9] because the licensee failed to perform a thorough search during MILE issue.

If you contest this finding, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region I; the Director, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response; the Director, Office of Enforcement, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001; and the NRC resident inspector at the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.390 "Public Inspections, Exemptions, Requests for Withholding," of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC's Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).
