Dear Director:

As required by License Condition 11.1 Strata Energy Inc. (Strata) hereby submits the Semiannual Environmental and Effluent Report for the period of April 24 (date of initial license issuance) through June 30, 2014. This report satisfies the requirements of 10 CFR 40.65.

No development or construction activities have been undertaken at the Ross Project site since issuance of SUA-1601. There have been no drilling activities. Due to the lack of activities at the site that would result in disturbances or the production or release of source or byproduct material no effluent and environmental monitoring was conducted during the reporting period.

The only monitoring activity governed by SUA-1601 during the period was the continued operation of a Meteorological Station as required under License Condition 12.13. On May 1, 2014 Strata submitted additional meteorological data analysis and a license amendment request to remove License Condition 12.13.

Strata will implement the environmental monitoring program required under SUA-1601 when major construction activities commence at the Ross site.


Strata will submit quarterly reports as required under License Condition 11.1 (A) and (B) when operations (lixiviant injection) commence at the site.
