As per 10 CFR 32.14, we are required to submit a report detailing product transferred to other persons from our facility every year. Therefore please let this letter serve as our report by noting the following information:


These products are transferred for use under 10CFR 30.15.

All units transferred from our facility which contain byproduct material have been in the form of a finished product. This product is a Smoke Detector with Integral Door Holder/Release Mechanism. It is an NRC Registered Device (# NR-782-D-101-E) and contains 0.9uCi of Americium-241.

The total number of units shipped from 01-01-2013 through 12-31-2013 is 674 pieces. The total amount of Americium-241 would therefore be $(480 \times 0.9\text{uCi}) = 606.6\text{uCi}$.

SUBJECT: MS SEDCO, INC., REQUEST FOR EXEMPT DISTRIBUTION ANNUAL
TRANSFER REPORTS

Dear Mr. Stults:

After carefully reviewing our records, it appears that we do not have record of your exempt distribution transfer reports for the 2012 and 2013 reporting periods.

As you are authorized, under 10 CFR 32.14, to transfer certain products containing byproduct materials to individuals exempt from regulatory requirements, you must abide by the reporting requirements for your license, which are listed in 10 CFR 32.16. These requirements include the provision that you submit an annual report to the NRC detailing transfers taking place during the previous calendar year.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 32.16, you must include the following information in your annual transfer reports:

- identification of the licensee, including the license number;
- indication that the products transferred for use under 10 CFR 30.15 or equivalent Agreement State regulation(s);
- a description and/or identification of the type of each product, including the model number(s) (if applicable);
- the total quantity of each radionuclide contained in each type of product/model; and
- the number of units of each type of product transferred, by model number (if applicable), during the reporting period.

These reports do not need to list each individual transfer (e.g. by date or recipient) or each individual unit transferred (e.g. by serial number), but must list the total number of units of each device type or model transferred for each reporting period. Also, if no transfers take place during a given reporting period, you are still required to submit a report stating so explicitly.

Pursuant to the regulations, your annual transfer reports must be submitted by January 31 each year, covering transfers that took place during the preceding calendar year. You should submit reports by mailing them to the following address:

or by some other means listed in 10 CFR 30.6(a).


Please submit copies of your reports for the 2012 and 2013 reporting periods within 30 calendar days of the date of this letter, so that we may incorporate them into our records.

NRC review of your response to this letter will determine whether further action is necessary to ensure appropriate retention of annual transfer reports.
