

**Withdrawal of Request for Foreign Ownership, Control or Influence Determination for American Centrifuge Manufacturing, LLC**

Dear Ms. Holahan:

On July 2, 2014 (Reference 1), USEC Inc. (USEC) submitted updated information for a Foreign Ownership, Control or Influence (FOCI) determination for its subsidiary, American Centrifuge Manufacturing, LLC (ACM) to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for review. Subsequently, based on interagency coordination related to transitioning the facility to a possessing status with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) as the Cognizant Security Agency, it has been determined that processing the FOCI package by the NRC should be terminated. Accordingly, USEC hereby withdraws its request for a FOCI determination for ACM contained in its July 2, 2014, letter.
