REQUEST FOR PARTICIPATION IN SAFETY CULTURE OUTREACH SURVEY

ADDRESSEES

All U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) materials licensees.

PURPOSE

The NRC is conducting a voluntary survey to gather feedback on safety culture communications and outreach activities related to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Safety Culture Policy Statement.

BACKGROUND

In June 2011, the NRC issued its Safety Culture Policy Statement, which describes the Commission's expectation that individuals and organizations establish and maintain a positive safety culture commensurate with the safety and security significance of their activities and the nature and complexity of their organizations and functions (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML111650336). Since that time, NRC staff has been conducting communications and outreach activities to engage and educate the regulated community on the contents of the policy statement and the importance of a positive safety culture. The NRC will use the information from this survey to determine if communication and outreach activities have been effective in promoting awareness of the Safety Culture Policy Statement, and to determine if changes to current activities and/or new activities are necessary and appropriate.

REQUEST

This is a voluntary information collection activity. Please direct this survey to the individual in your organization who is most familiar with your safety policies, such as a Safety Officer, Compliance Officer, or other manager or technical staff member with these responsibilities. The individual completing the survey for your organization may consider gathering information from your staff to provide the most informed response. **Only one response per licensee is requested.** The survey should take approximately 20 minutes to complete. All responses will be kept confidential and will not be attributed to a particular individual or organization.


