There are a couple of items that I need to request and confirm before I can issue the amendment to your license.

1. Please submit documentation (certificate) to show that the proposed RSO, Mr. Steve Campbell, has obtained formal training in the establishment and maintenance of a radiation protection program. (You may contact the manufacturer of the sources and devices and they'll be able to tell you the additional acceptable training. Please note that this training is different than the radiographer training).
2. Please confirm that the proposed RSO, Mr. Steve Campbell, is trustworthy and reliable in accordance with 10 CFR 37.21(b). (<http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/cfr/part037/>). Please note that 10 CFR Part 37, "Physical Protection of Category 1 and Category 2 Quantities of Radioactive Material," became effective on March 19, 2014.

We are trying to expedite your amendment request and upon receipt and acceptable review of the above information, we will try to issue the amendment by Friday, August 22nd.

Per our recent telephone conversation, today, it has come to our attention that you no longer have a Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) identified on your license. Please note that you are prohibited from using radioactive material in NRC jurisdiction until an amendment to your license has been issued identifying a valid RSO. Please see Section 8.7.1 of NUREG-1556, Vol. 2 for the training and experience for an industrial radiography licensee's RSO. (<http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v2/>). Please submit this amendment request including your license number and docket number (License Number 17-35125-01; Docket Number 030-38725) as soon as practical and we will expedite your request.

I will forward you an email regarding the completion of Form 748 for the National Source Tracking System under separate cover.
