

Dear Mr. Saltzman:

I am transmitting for your information six copies each of Endorsements 9, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15 to NELIA Policy No. NF-180 covering H. B. Robinson Unit No. 2. Endorsement No. 10 dealt with advance premium and was deleted by Endorsement No. 11. You will note that Endorsement No. 13 extends the policy limits to \$63,550,000. Endorsement No. 15 deletes Endorsement No. 8. With deletion of Endorsement No. 8 (which amended Endorsement No. 1), the site description is as defined in Endorsement No. 1 and shown on the H. B. Robinson plot plan forwarded to you on June 12, 1970.


The MAELU coverage has been effected by our insurance broker and copy of the policy will be forwarded to you as soon as the same has been received by the Company.


- 1a. ADVANCE PREMIUM: It is agreed that the Advance Premium due the companies for the period designated above is: \$ 100.00

2. It is agreed that with respect to bodily injury or property damage caused, during the effective period of this endorsement, by the nuclear energy hazard:
- a. The word "companies" wherever used in the policy means the subscribing companies listed on the reverse side of this endorsement.
 - b. The policy shall be binding on such companies only.
 - c. Each such company shall be liable only for its proportion of any obligation assumed or expense incurred under the policy because of such bodily injury or property damage as designated on the reverse side of this endorsement.
3. It is agreed that the effective period of this endorsement is to the close of December 31 of the Calendar Year designated in the caption above, or to the time of the termination or cancelation of the policy, if sooner.



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

INCREASE OF LIMIT OF LIABILITY ENDORSEMENT

It is agreed that:

1. The limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations of the policy is amended to read 63,550,000.

This amended limit applies with respect to obligations assumed or expenses incurred because of bodily injury or property damage caused, during the period from the effective date of this endorsement to the date of termination of the policy, by the nuclear energy hazard.

2. The limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above shall not be cumulative, and each payment made by the companies after the effective date of this endorsement for any loss or expense covered by the policy shall reduce by the amount of such payment both the limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above, regardless of which limit of liability applies with respect to the bodily injury or property damage out of which such loss or expenses arises.






