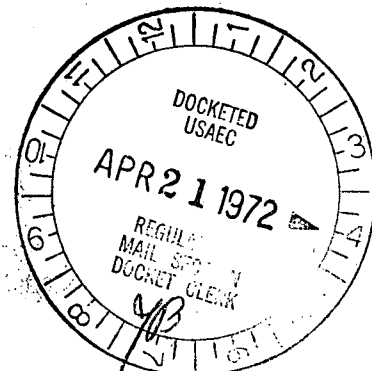

SUPPLEMENTARY ENDORSEMENT WAIVER OF DEFENSES REACTOR CONSTRUCTION AT THE FACILITY

It is agreed that in construing the application of paragraph 2(b) of the Waiver of Defenses Endorsement (NE-33) with respect to an extraordinary nuclear occurrence occurring at the facility, a claimant who is employed at the facility in connection with the construction of a nuclear reactor with respect to which no operating license has been issued by the Atomic Energy Commission shall not be considered as employed in connection with the activity where the extraordinary nuclear occurrence takes place if:

- (1) the claimant is employed exclusively in connection with the construction of a nuclear reactor, including all related equipment and installations at the facility, and
- (2) no operating license has been issued by the Atomic Energy Commission with respect to the nuclear reactor, and
- (3) the claimant is not employed in connection with the possession, storage, use or transfer of nuclear material at the facility.

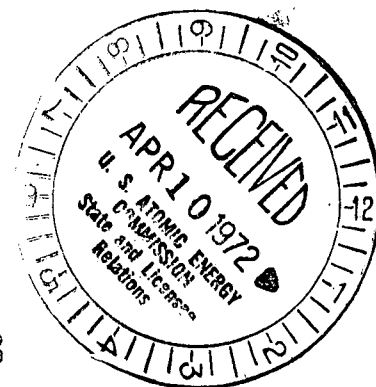
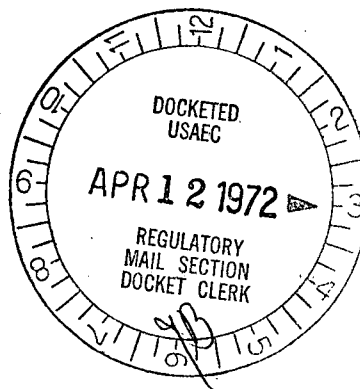

MUTUAL ATOMIC ENERGY LIABILITY UNDERWRITERS

INCREASE OF LIMIT OF LIABILITY ENDORSEMENT (After Prior Increase)

It is agreed that:


1. The limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations is amended to read \$21,375,000. This amended limit applies with respect to obligations assumed or expenses incurred because of bodily injury or property damage caused, during the period from the effective date of this endorsement to the date of termination of the policy, by the nuclear energy hazard.
2. The original limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above shall not be cumulative, and each payment made by the companies after the effective date of this endorsement for any loss or expense covered by the policy shall reduce by the amount of such payment the limit of liability originated in Item 4 of the declarations and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above, regardless of which limit of liability applies with respect to the bodily injury or property damage out of which such loss or expense arises.

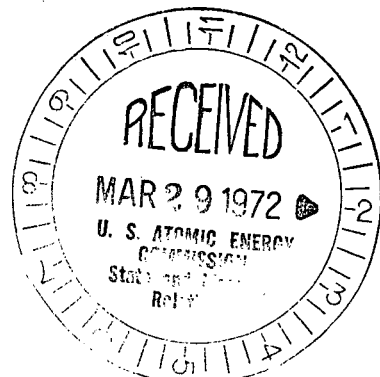
