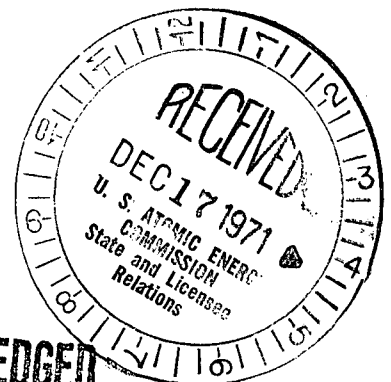
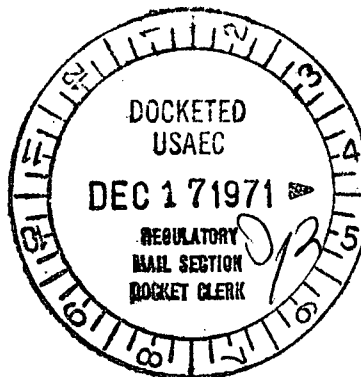

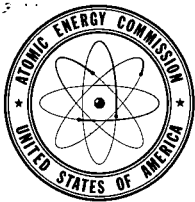

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-43

AMENDMENT NO. 2


Effective December 14, 1971, Indemnity Agreement No. B-43 between Carolina Power and Light Company and the Atomic Energy Commission, dated December 4, 1969, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Article II is amended by adding the following proviso at the end of subparagraph 5(c):

"Provided, however, that with respect to an extraordinary nuclear occurrence occurring at the facility, a claimant who is employed at the facility in connection with the construction of a nuclear reactor with respect to which no operating license has been issued by the Atomic Energy Commission shall not be considered as employed in connection with the activity where the extraordinary nuclear occurrence takes place if:

- (1) the claimant is employed exclusively in connection with the construction of a nuclear reactor, including all related equipment and installations at the facility, and
- (2) no operating license has been issued by the AEC with respect to the nuclear reactor, and
- (3) the claimant is not employed in connection with the possession, storage, use or transfer of nuclear material at the facility."

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-43

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Effective **JUL 31 1970**, Indemnity Agreement No. B-43, dated December 4, 1969, between Carolina Power & Light Company and the Atomic Energy Commission, is hereby amended as follows:

Item 2a of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

Item 2 - Amount of financial protection

- a. \$ 1,000,000 (From 12:01 a.m., December 4, 1969, to 12:00 midnight, **JUL 30 1970**, inclusive)  
\$82,000,000 (From 12:01 a.m., **JUL 31 1970**)

Item 3 of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

Item 3 - License number or numbers

- SNM-1160 (From 12:01 a.m., December 4, 1969, to 12:00 midnight, **JUL 30 1970**, inclusive)  
DPR-23 (From 12:01 a.m., **JUL 31 1970**)

Item 4 of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

The Unit 2 Nuclear Fuel Handling Building of the H. B. Robinson Power Station. Said location is in the western corner of Darlington County, South Carolina, approximately 5 miles west northwest of the town of Hartsville.

(From 12:01 a.m., December 4, 1969 to 12:00 midnight, **JUL 30 1970**, inclusive)

All buildings and premises owned or occupied by or rented to Carolina Power & Light Company, known as H. B. Robinson Power Station which is located within the heavy dashed line on the copy of H. B. Robinson Plot Plan dated June 5, 1970, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and including the

seal well for Unit No. 2 at the discharge canal and the intake structure for Unit No. 2 with pertinent piping as shown on the plot plan. Said location is in the western corner of Darlington County, South Carolina, approximately 5 miles west northwest of the town of Hartsville.
