Hi Jackie,

I left you a message regarding our license amendment (Materials License 49-10982-02; Amendment No. 30, Docket No. 030 13772).

Upon deeper inspection of your letter, I think that some elements of my request may have been poorly stated or perhaps misunderstood. I have attached the original letter to the NRC.

It was not my intent to have Dr. Stamato removed from the license as an Authorized User. Although we will not be performing brachytherapy, Dr. Stamato is still on the medical staff and if I understand the conditions of our license correctly, he is still is authorized to perform procedures requiring a written directive, such as I131 Tx.

As we do not have an RSO that is qualified to supervise brachytherapy procedures, I agree that our brachytherapy sources should be classified as "For storage only" and we are not permitted to perform those procedures at this facility. However, I believe that Dr. Stamato should be re-listed as an Authorized User for 35.300 and 35.400 even though our program is dormant.
