Discussion: I asked Mr. Newsome, what he meant by "abatement of the Notice of Violation." He stated that it is used with other government agencies to ask for a reduction in severity level. I told Mr. Newsome that the severity level was already at the lowest level that we would cite. I asked if he would like to dispute the violation. We discussed the dispute process and he decided that he did not wish to dispute the violation.

I told him that I needed more for his corrective actions. Actions should demonstrate that the license is being put to use with materials. After discussion of corrective actions, he agreed to send in writing a commitment to either terminate the license or transfer the generally licensed devices to the specific license within 30 days of receiving his license renewal.
