Dear Richard,

My name is Haimanot Yilma and I am the Project Manager for the proposed Dewey-Burdock project. We spoke briefly about two weeks ago regarding the development of the Programmatic Agreement for the Dewey-Burdock project and the possibility of the WY SHPO's office being a signatory to this PA as the line of sight analysis will cross into WY. Similar to other projects in WY, we are performing a line of sight analysis within 3 miles of the tallest structure proposed for the Dewey-Burdock project. Randy Withrow will be in WY next week for another project and while he is there, he would like to stop by your office and conduct some research for this line of sight analysis.
