Dear Mr. Mahowald,

I reached out to the Prairie Island Indian Community (PIIC) in a letter dated April 3, 2014 (ML14100A354) providing the opportunity to comment on the draft federal register notice (FRN) regarding the environmental assessment (EA) and finding of no significant impact for a Prairie Island Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation physical security exemption request. Subsequently, the FRN was revised. Because of this revision, we wanted to give you the opportunity to review the revised draft FRN.

In your response to my letter (ML14154A370) you indicated that PIIC had additional concerns and questions that you wished to discuss. You stated that it was difficult to evaluate and provide comments on the draft EA without access to the safety evaluation report (SER) prepared by the NRC staff as part of its evaluation of the exemption request. The SER is not a publically available document. The NRC staff has determined that PIIC has a need to know the information contained in the SER. Accordingly, please find a copy of the draft SER attached. Please note that the enclosed draft staff evaluation is marked Official Use Only – Security Related Information, should be controlled as such, and should not be further disseminated without NRC authorization.

As part of our review of this physical security exemption request, we consult Federal and State agencies and persons affected by the licensing action. The consultation is done prior to issuing the final EA. The purpose of the consultation is to solicit comments on the environmental impact of the proposed action and any other comments pertaining to the proposed action. Please note

that we document in the "Agencies and Persons Consulted" of the federal register notice that the consultations occurred and summarize the comments received.

Please provide any comments on the attached draft EA and finding of no significant impact by **August 11, 2014**. Should you not be able to support this date, please contact me to discuss an alternate date.

If I can provide any additional assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me or my branch chief, Timothy Lupold. I thank you in advance for both your time and consideration.
