Dear Ms. Shanley,

In support of the request signed by Mr. Daglio to add Drs. Blanco and Dr. Mah to the license, please submit the following additional information:

1. As noted in our procedures located at <http://www.nrc.gov/materials/miau/med-use-toolkit/seed-localization.html>, "the authorized user should be considered qualified for implementation, localization and removal of the seeds if the individual is listed on a license (NRC or Agreement State)". Please provide the license listing Drs. Blanco and Mah as authorized users for 10 CFR 35.200 licensed material. If neither is listed on a license, please submit detailed training and experience documentation for each physician documenting 700 hours, including a minimum of 80 hours of classroom and laboratory training. NRC, Form 313A(AUD) may be used to document the training and preceptor attestation and may be found at [http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc313a\(aud\).pdf](http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc313a(aud).pdf). Please note that: (i) the training must have been obtained within the last 7 years in accordance with 10 CFR 35.59, or the individual must have had related continuing experience since the required training was completed; and (ii) the board certifications provided were issued greater than 7 years ago and do not include "AU Eligible" above the seal and therefore do not meet NRC requirements.
2. Please indicate whether 10 CFR 35.200 uses should be included for each physician.
3. Please provide documentation of the casework completed by both physicians involving the safe **removal** of sources contained in tissue, with proper shielding of the removed sources for transfer to pathology.

Please respond within 30 days to this request for information. If we do not receive a response within 30 days, we will consider that you no longer need the addition and will void your request. You may reply via facsimile to 610-337-5269 or via an emailed pdf of your signed response to my attention. Please respond to this email to indicate that you received the request for information and thank you for your assistance.
