Purpose of the Meeting:

The purpose of this meeting was to provide members of the community an opportunity to meet with NRC staff members to discuss issues related to the Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3, including the results of the NRC's assessment of safety performance at the Waterford Steam Electric Station during calendar year 2013 (NRC's annual assessment letter, ADAMS Accession No. ML14063A597, and NRC's follow-up assessment letter, ADAMS Accession No. ML14093A093). This meeting was meant to provide members of the public an opportunity to ask questions about the NRC's purpose and responsibilities and to discuss any regulatory issues.

General Details:

The NRC conducted an open house beginning from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Central daylight time (CDT) where members of the public met with NRC staff and asked questions related to license renewal, equipment aging, radioactive plant emissions, spent fuel storage, the reactor oversight process, and the resident inspector program. Four NRC staff members were present: Gregory Werner, Chief, Project Branch E, Division of Reactor Projects, Region IV; Frances Ramirez, Senior Resident Inspector; Chris Speer, Resident Inspector; and Linda Dufrene, Administrative Assistant. The meeting was dedicated to answering questions on the previously stated topics, as well as the status of Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3, and receiving comments from members of the public.

Approximately 25 people attended the meeting. Five of those people were members of the public. Other participants included St. John the Baptist and St. Charles Parish Emergency Operations Centers staff, Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality staff, Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Planning staff, and representatives of the licensee. Numerous participants asked questions.

Public Participation Themes:

During the meeting, NRC staff addressed questions on the following topics:

- Equipment aging - the NRC conducts regular inspections regarding maintenance of plant equipment related to safety
- Radioactive emissions from the plant - plants must report to the NRC when they release radioactivity above set amounts
- Spent nuclear fuel storage - NRC considers dry cask storage to be safe
- Reactor Oversight Process – includes a combination of independent inspections and plant-reported performance indicators to assess plant performance
