RESULTS OF LICENSED PERSONNEL TESTING

Gentlemen:

This provides the Carolina Power & Light Company reply to the NRC request which was transmitted by letter dated February 1, 1993. The letter expressed an interest in our plans to test the knowledge of licensed personnel in areas outside the scope of NRC administered licensed operator examinations. Specifically you requested to be informed of the results of this testing.

Shortly after our meeting on January 21, 1993, a closed book, 158 question examination was given to a group of forty-nine (49) licensed operators and Shift Technical Advisors. The overall (average) score for the 49 exams was seventy-five (75) percent.

The examination and the results were reviewed with the operators. There were 38 questions missed by greater than forty (40) percent of the operators. Additional training was conducted on these 38 questions in Licensed Operator Requalification (LOR). A retest of these areas of knowledge was given as a portion of weekly LOR examinations that followed. Results of the weekly LOR exams indicated that the operators had a satisfactory knowledge level of the material.
