LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, October 18, 2015, and depart on Friday, October 23, 2015. Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at 844-244-6694 for airline reservations, and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC.
