

9 and 9a (additional clarification)

The final end-use of the nuclear material sent to Russia will be nuclear fuel loaded and consumed at U.S. or Euratom (European) nuclear power plants, owned or operated by ConverDyn's utility customers. Uranium hexafluoride shipped from the Honeywell Metropolis plant to Russia will be enriched at the Russian enrichment complex (Techsnabexport), sent to a U.S. or European fabricator for manufacturing into fuel rods, shipped back to the commercial U.S. or European power plants for use.

11. Foreign Obligations (best estimate at time of application submittal)

If a ConverDyn Customer requests shipment of foreign-obligated natural uranium during the term of this export license, the license will be amended to include it. However, at this time we are not aware of any foreign-obligations for natural uranium hexafluoride to be shipped under this license, except Russian, as indicated on page 1 of this Application. Otherwise, we expect all material shipped under this license will be U.S. obligated, only.
