Dear Mr. Miller,

When a licensee terminates licensed activities, the regulations in 10 CFR 30.35(g), 40.36(f), 70.25(g), and 72.30(d) require that records of information important to decommissioning be transferred to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission to ensure their long-term availability.

Please transfer the following records, as were applicable to your program, that pertain to:

- a. the decommissioning of your facility including records of burials; and
- b. records of offsite releases and waste disposal including effluent releases, release to sewers, incineration, and radioactive material spills.

Records may be transferred to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I, 2100 Renaissance Boulevard, Suite 100, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406.

No license terminations will be authorized unless all records considered important to the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility in 10 CFR 30.35(g), 40.36(f), 70.25(g), and 72.30(d); have been transferred to the Commission for license terminations.
